JOINT WINNERS OF ANNUAL NOISE AWARD

To mark International Noise Awareness Day **(1)** the UK Noise Association announced the winner of its annual Jack Pease Media Award **(2)** presented to the individual or organisation which has done the most to raise the profile of noise during the course of the year.

This year there were joint winners. SoundPrint, the New York-based organisation which developed the pioneering Noise App which enables to measure the noise in a venue, and the UK-based Mumbli, which works with venues to improve the noise climate for customers. During the last year the two organisation embarked on a joint project.

Val Weedon, President of the UK Noise Association, said, "This is a well-deserved award. For years customers have been complaining about noise in venues. SoundPrint and Mumbli have come up with positive ways of tackling it".
